

The Sensory System and its Effect on Behavior

Our sensory system allows our brains to receive information and to use this information to respond to the environment to feel comfortable and safe. A child that has an over or under responsive sensory system will face challenges in the classroom that often are viewed as challenging behaviors rather than as the child's expression of sensory system issues. Participants will explore the sensory system, how it may interfere with a child's development, and how to help children and families as the child's sensory system matures.
